

Thank you for downloading these job aids from the **Global Alliance for Vitamin A (GAVA)**. Please read the following notes prepared for this package:

- These pictorial videos were designed as job aids for frontline health workers who have already received training on how to safely administer vitamin A supplementation (VAS) in the context of COVID-19; they are not meant to be used as a stand-alone training tool.
- The videos were designed to complement comprehensive training that encompasses local guidelines and follows the detailed guidance in the **GAVA operational guide on administering VAS in the context of COVID-19**. Frontline workers should be encouraged to follow all local guidelines for infection, prevention and control (IPC) for COVID-19.
- The videos were developed to apply globally, across many contexts. As such, the images and instructions in the videos may not reflect local/national guidelines related to IPC for COVID-19.
- These videos are small in size and intended to be shared through mobile apps like What's App and other smartphone platforms, to reach all frontline workers involved in VAS distribution.
- The 3 videos included in this package are described below:

VIDEO 1

How to administer VAS in the context of COVID-19 at fixed sites

This video is for frontline workers who deliver VAS at fixed sites, such as health centres, health posts or sites within the community.

VIDEO 2

How to administer VAS in the context of COVID-19 at households

This video is for frontline workers who deliver VAS at households (door-to-door).

VIDEO 3

How to administer VAS in the context of COVID-19 using the caregiver method

This video is for all frontline workers who deliver VAS, as this method may be required if medical masks are unavailable or if a positive screening is encountered. See the **GAVA guide** for more information.
